

Conjuncts classified

Some conjuncts cannot occur finally in the clause, some must be final, and some must be initial. Most clausal conjuncts (such as *by that I mean, a case in point is, given that, by which is meant* etc.) only occur initially. Most conjuncts occur conventionally in initial position, followed by a comma, and may appear in mid-position, separated by commas.
